

## **Procedures for Students in Schools During a Pandemic**

Students will be greeted outside and will be given direction, spacing instruction, and mask reminders.

Mask reminders: EVERYONE must wear a mask. Masks must be surgical, KN95, N95, or multilayer cloth. If cloth, it must be washed every night. NO GATORS are allowed. There are NO mask Breaks. It is NEVER okay to take mask down from nose and mouth to speak.

Students will go through metal detectors and get breakfast while maintaining social distancing. All students will be required to go to class. If a student becomes ill during the day, they will be sent home. Ill students must be picked up within 30-45 minutes of parents/guardians being contacted by the school. Students will be directed to a holding room until their parents/guardian arrives to pick them up.

Students who have ongoing medical conditions and need to see the nurse for medications, have injuries that must be looked at, or need nursing attention and do not have ANY symptoms of COVID-19 will be directed or escorted to the nurse's office.

Class expectations and hallway movement will be very structured. Students and staff are expected to follow all hallway directions. You will follow the arrows and signs that are posted throughout the building.

Water fountains are not available. Water bottles will be provided. You may bring your own water bottle.

Not following COVID-19 safety guidelines is a violation of the district code of conduct. If violated disciplinary action may be administered for violators.
